### **What is Pink Shirt Day?**

*Pink Shirt Day is an anti-bullying movement that started in Canada. It began in 2007 when two high school students in Nova Scotia, saw a younger student being bullied for wearing a pink shirt. In response, they bought dozens of pink shirts and encouraged their classmates to wear them in solidarity. The movement grew, and now Pink Shirt Day is recognized annually on the last Wednesday of February in Canada and other countries.*

*The day promotes kindness, inclusion, and raising awareness about bullying prevention in schools, workplaces, and communities. People wear pink to show their support for anti-bullying efforts.*

*While there is no work environment or school that has 0% bullying, we do our best to teach our students how to be kind, respectful and responsible citizens in hopes to inch closer to that 0% mark.*
