Measles Information- What you need to know in a school setting!

Measles is a rash that appears 3 to 7 days after fever starts, usually beginning behind the ears and on the face and spreading down to the body and then to the arms and legs. Under Alberta's Public Health Act, any person in Alberta who has been exposed to measles and who is susceptible to measles, are required to stay home for the period of time starting five days after first exposure to a case of measles through 21 days after

the last exposure to a case of measles. This means that if there is a measles outbreak in your child's class and your child is not vaccinated, they may be missing multiple months of school by the time the last exposure goes through the class.
